<u>Uniform</u>

PE kit (on Mondays and Fridays) is not an excuse for non-uniform. T-shirts are to be plain white, without patterns or logos and leggings/joggers/shorts should be plain, logo-free and dark in colour.

Snack Price Increase—Monday 17th April

Due to increased food costs, with effect from Monday 17th April, our Friday bacon butty will now cost **85p**. The cost of a slice of toast will be **35p** and half a bagel will also be **35p**.

School Dinner Price Increase—Monday 5th June

<u>Selfless Shelves supporting the West Cheshire Foodbank - All in, bring a tin!</u>

We think that Capenhurst is a welcoming community that includes everyone irrespective of race, gender or religion.

The 'Selfless Shelves' is a project where



children can earn a token as a reward for a good deed in school. This token can then be exchanged for a food item from the 'Selfless Shelves' which can then be placed in the Foodbank.
