...we have been preparing for the season of Harvest. Children have used time in Worship and RE to reflect on what Harvest means to them. Our shared story of the Feeding of the 5000 demonstrates the power of sharing food and companionship, even if you are only able to offer a little to the table, everything counts. During the season of Harvest we also show our gratitude and thankfulness for what we have, what we can share with others and what others have shared with us. Contributions to the Harvest food collection can be brought into school and/or to the service on Sunday 8th October. This is at Holy Trinity Church, starting at 11.15am - all are welcome.

Harvest Service - Sunday 8th October, 11.15am

Thank you for your replies about the Harvest Service which will take place at Holy Trinity this Sunday, 8th October. For those families who replied to say their child would like an active part in the service, the order of service and/or reading that your child will be reading was sent home on Friday. Mrs Green will be there leading the service with Rev Alan Leach, as will other members of staff, so those children taking part will be supported by someone familiar from school. Please help your child feel confident with their part by rehearsing it a few times at home.

All families are welcome to attend, even if their child is not taking an active part in the service. It is preferred that the children wear their school uniform. The service starts at 11.15am, please arrive a little before.

Class 3 Farm Visit - Thursday 5th October

A reminder that Class 3 children should wear their PE kit on Thursday for their visit to the farm. Please ensure that joggers/ leggings are worn (not shorts) due to the long grass. Please bring **wellies** (ideally) or old trainers to change into. Please apply insect spray (if required) to your child before school and remember to bring a coat.

Lady Lever Art Gallery Trip - Thursday 19th October

We have arranged a whole school trip to the Lady Lever Art Gallery in Port Sunlight on Thursday 19th October.

Your child will need to wear his/her school uniform as usual (making sure this includes either a jumper or a cardigan), as well as a packed lunch which should be fully disposable in a named carrier bag; no lunch boxes please. Alternatively, our school cook can provide a packed lunch and you should indicate on the ParentMail form if you would like her to do so. Your child will also need to bring a coat.

We will be travelling by coach and will be back at school in time for the end of the school day at 3.15pm. We ask for a donation of £5 towards the transport cost which can be paid via ParentMail. If your child receives income-related free school meals, school will cover this cost for you.

Please ensure that you complete the ParentMail form as soon as possible but by Monday 2nd October at the latest.

Selfless Shelves supporting the West Cheshire Foodbank - All in, bring a tin!

We think that Capenhurst is a welcoming community that includes everyone irrespective of race, gender or religion. The 'Selfless Shelves' is a project where children can earn a token as a reward for a good deed in school. This token can then be exchanged for a food item from the 'Selfless Shelves' which can then be placed in the Foodbank. Everyone is encouraged to bring items for the shelves - the children see this as a 'Circle of Kindness'. We encourage families to help out over the next few days by bringing in things for the Selfless Shelves. All in, bring a tin!



The Foodbank will then use these items to support local families struggling to provide food for themselves. We will continue to support the West Cheshire Foodbank in our traditional way and food items can be brought in and placed on the 'Selfless Shelves' or directly into the collection box. The Foodbank is particularly in need of **UHT juice, custard, cup a soup, jams and spreads and tinned potatoes.**
