Sending Money into the Office

Please ensure that all payments coming into the office are in a named envelope with a list of what is inside. You do not need to use a separate envelope for each item. Please send the envelope into school with your child. They are well aware of our morning routine and are used to handing in payments during registration. This should help to ease congestion in the office.

It would also be appreciated if parents/carers would refrain from bringing payments into the office at the end of the school day, particularly on Fridays. Mrs Auld leaves school at 12.30pm on Fridays and all payments are prepared for banking before midday. If this can not be avoided, please ensure the payments are in a named envelope as above. Payment reminders are sent by text or by a 'compliment slip reminder' so everyone should be aware of the amounts outstanding. which should reduce duplication of work for the office staff.

The price of a school meal is currently £2.25 for children in Years 3-6. A slice of toast/half a bagel is 30p and a bacon butty (Fridays only) is 60p.
