In worship this week...

...we have looked at how communities need to pay attention to individuals and get to know them for the community to work as one. This is a strength of school and what makes our community work well as one. We have the added dimension of being part of the a wider Christian community with our church, diocese and beyond.

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Class 2 Farm Visit - Thursday 2nd May

Class 2 will be visiting the farm on Thursday morning. Your child will need to come to school in their PE kit, ensuring that he/ she wears <u>dark jogging bottoms (not shorts)</u>, due to the hay and long grass. Your child should wear a pair of trainers to school and bring a pair of wellies (preferable) or old trainers for the morning trip in a separate named bag. Your child will also need their school cardigan/jumper and a warm coat, scarf, hat and gloves. An extra/spare pair of socks would be a good idea to help keep feet warm! Thank you.

Sunday 5th May - Holy Trinity Church Service

On Sunday 5th May, the Venerable Dr Michael Gilbertson, the Archdeacon of Chester, will be visiting, and taking the 11:15am Service, at Holy Trinity Church. This will be a lovely opportunity for the school community to welcome him to the community of Capenhurst and also demonstrate the value we place on our relationship with Holy Trinity as an extension of our school. It would be lovely if there were plenty of people to greet him on the day. I know the regular worshippers at Holy Trinity appreciate and enjoy our presence when we attend at various points in the year. I hope some of you are able to make space for it in your busy weekend plans. Children do not need to be in school uniform.

Selfless Shelves supporting the West Cheshire Foodbank - All in, bring a tin!

We think that Capenhurst is a welcoming community that includes everyone irrespective of race, gender or religion. The 'Selfless Shelves' is a project where children can earn a token as a reward for a good deed in school. This token can then be exchanged for a food item from the 'Selfless Shelves' which can then be placed in the Foodbank. Everyone is encouraged to bring items for the shelves - the children see this as a 'Circle of Kindness'. We encourage families to help out over the next few days by bringing in things for the Selfless Shelves. All in, bring a tin!



The Foodbank will then use these items to support local families struggling to provide food for themselves. We will continue to support the West Cheshire Foodbank in our traditional way and food items can be brought in and placed on the 'Selfless Shelves' or directly into the collection box. The Foodbank is particularly in need of **UHT Juice**, **instant mash**, **tinned fruit**, **tinned meats/meat meals and toiletries**, **especially deodorant**.
