## D-Day Celebrations - Saturday 8th June

On Saturday 8th June, the Parish Council are displaying some original memorabilia in the village hall, from the war years. Some are 'hands-on' from the local military museum. There will be a fish and chip van offering some free portions, the WI serving tea/coffee/soft drinks and cakes for a small donation and ice creams also at a reduced cost. There will be a raffle and the winners of the colouring and writing competitions will be announced; details of the competitions were sent home on 22nd May via ParentMail. The fish and chip van is setting up for 5.30pm, the village hall will be open at 4.30pm. They hope to see as many members of the school community there as possible.

## Class 2 Farm Visit - Thursday 6th June

Class 2 will be visiting the farm on Thursday morning. Your child will need to come to school in their PE kit, ensuring that he/she wears dark jogging bottoms (not shorts), due to the hay and long grass. Your child should wear a pair of trainers to school and bring a pair of wellies (preferable) or old trainers for the morning trip in a separate named bag. Your child will also need their school cardigan/jumper and a coat. An extra/spare pair of socks would be a good idea to help keep feet warm!

If your child needs insect spray, please administer this at home prior to school. Please do not send any insect spray into school as it will be a distraction and the children should not be carrying medication with them in their coats or bags.

If your child suffers from hayfever, it would be helpful if you could give a dose of antihistamine in the morning before school and email school at [contact@capenhurstcep.cheshire.sch.uk](mailto:contact@capenhurstcep.cheshire.sch.uk) to let us know that you have done so.
