Premier Sports

Mr Hartley will be returning to teach PE across school this year. He will also be awarding a PE award each week to one pupil who has excelled in some way in his lessons. This is a new award and will be handed out during sharing assembly each week. We are able to continue with this high quality P.E. provision through careful deployment of the Sports Premium funding which is delegated to each school to enhance P.E. provision for all children. We also spend this money on subsiding after-school clubs and other sporting activities as well as paying for swimming teaching and lifeguard provision for school swimming lessons. School lunches

We have a new three weekly rolling menu for school lunches this year. The menus were sent home with your youngest child last week and are also on the school website, <u>www.capenhurstcep.cheshire.sch.uk</u> and on the noticeboard on the side of school.

From September 2018, the price of a school lunch has increased to £2.30 for children in Year 3 and above (who are not eligible for a free school meal). Children in EYFS, Y1 or Y2 are still able to receive a free school meal. Prices for snacks remain the same, (30p for toast/half a bagel; 60p for a bacon butty - Fridays only). Please send payment in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name and what is enclosed. Cheques should be made payable to "CWAC". Thanks.

Swimming Lessons for Y3-Y6

Swimming lessons start on Tuesday 11th September for children in KS2 for the duration of the Autumn Term. Please ensure your child arrives at school on time as we will be leaving promptly at 9am in order to arrive in Chester on time. Your child will need to bring appropriate swim wear (one piece swimsuit), goggles if your child usually wears them, and a towel each Wednesday morning. If needed, they should bring a snack from home, as they will miss morning school break so there will be no toast available. It would be useful if they could come to school with their swim wear underneath their school uniform, but please remember to pack underwear for afterwards! Please ensure that consents are returned and payment for the coach transport is made by 11th September, unless you have made alternative arrangements with Mrs Auld. Thank you.
