Parents with children in Year 6 and pre-school children due to start school in September 2019 are reminded that you are now able to apply for Year 7 and reception places online via the Council's website at <u>www.cheshirewestandchester.gov.uk/</u> <u>admissions</u>

The deadline for high school applications is October 31st 2018. The local high schools will have open evenings to help you choose the right school for your child and details of these are available on their websites.

We held an open morning at 10am on Monday 1st October and an open afternoon at 1.30pm on Wednesday 3rd October for parents with children due to start school in September 2019 and some families were able to join us. We would welcome your help in publicising our school to friends and neighbours who might be interested in joining us and an appointment can be made for them to visit school. The closing date for primary school admissions is January 15th 2019.
