CAMHS Incredible Years Courses 2019

Following previously successful Incredible Years Programme courses for parents of primary aged children, West Cheshire CAMHS will again offer this in 2019. Parents can access this by self-referral basis as they do not hold a waiting list due to the limited places available and therefore places will be given on a first come, first served basis. CAMHS will be delivering two courses during 2019 in two separate venues, one in Neston and another in Chester.
