Sickness

I just wanted to update and reassure you all that following notification of a cluster of children developing the sickness bug, school contacted the Infection Prevention Service for their advice and guidance. The advice was to clean the school using bleach-based products, paying particular attention to all hard surfaces and toilets. It also advised that the task was undertaken once the children had left school at the end of the day. In order to ensure that this task was completed correctly, school contacted our cleaning contractor, to request another member of staff join Derek (our caretaker/cleaner) who arrived and started work as soon as school ended on Friday.

I have also been made aware of comments on Facebook about the bug and the actions taken by school. Just a reminder that social media is not an appropriate forum for raising concerns and complaints about the actions taken by school and its staff. We have always maintained an open-door policy within school that has worked well in the past enabling families and school to work together to the benefit of all children. I would like to feel that this way of working will continue and that parents will bring their concerns to school rather than posting them on Facebook and other social media forums.
