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Staffing at Capenhurst

Catering services are in the process of recruiting a replacement for Mrs Cadman. We have an interim cook - Miss Donna Sims - who will be preparing and cooking school lunches for the remainder of this week. I shall inform you of the permanent replacement as soon as I am able.

Recruitment of a replacement for Mrs Wilson has started and I shall keep you informed of the outcome as soon as I am able.

As you are aware we are part of the Schools Direct Initial Teacher Training programme with other local schools. Miss Bird will be starting her alternate placement at William Stockton Primary School on Monday 12th January and Miss Isobel Morrison will be joining Mrs Ritson and Class 3 on the same day for her alternate placement. Mrs Ritson has included details about her role in her letter outlining events and topics in Class 3. Miss Bird will be returning to Capenhurst for the summer term.

KS2 Residential

All pupils in Classes 3 and 4 will be bringing home a letter with the details of the forthcoming residential at the Conway Centre, Anglesey. The residential commences on Monday 23rd March with pupils returning on Wednesday 25th March. This is an exciting opportunity for all pupils to take part in outdoor and adventurous activities supervised and developed by expert tutors and course leaders as well as school staff. For those pupils who would prefer not take part, attendance at school as normal is expected and work will be set for them by their teachers. If costs make attendance difficult, please speak in confidence to a member of staff so that payment options can be discussed and agreed. Look out for the letter that will be sent home by Mrs Ritson and Mrs Bunting.

Instrumental tuition - Class 4

The children in Class 4 will be taking part in a 10 week instrumental tuition programme starting on Thursday 15th January. This will be at no additional cost to parents for the 10 week whole class sessions. The children will be learning to play either flute or clarinet, which will be provided free of charge (funded by Musical Routes Music Education Hub) to school for the children to use during these lessons. The children will be taught by a peripatetic music teacher - Mr Ged Barry - employed by QLP, the advisory team from the local authority. A short meeting will be arranged with parents prior to the instruments being taken home, the date will be agreed with Mr Barry when he visits school on Thursday 8th January to meet with Mrs Bunting. This is an exciting opportunity that it is hoped the children will enjoy. The possibility of further tuition after the initial 10 week programme will be explained later this term.
