#### SEND Consultation

The Council is running a consultation from **20<sup>th</sup> June until 12<sup>th</sup> September 2019** on services for children and young people with SEND needs, to help inform the future development of the service and would like to hear your views. In February 2018, Cheshire West and Chester Council commissioned a review of its high needs provision. This involved identifying the key issues and challenges facing the local area's SEND system and highlighting areas for development. They would really value your views on the proposed options under consideration to help shape the services provided to children, young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities.
