Collective Worship Summer 1: Peace and Love

A daily act of collective worship will be led by Claire on Mondays using Teams; by staff in their classrooms on Tuesday and Wednesday; on Thursday we will go to church from 1pm; on Fridays, Claire will lead Celebration worship (sharing assembly) in the hall. Use of reflective journals or thinking time can be used as an act of worship and there must be a moment of prayer – either spoken or silent to suit the theme, age of children and time of day. Children can be involved in leading worship. Songs can be listened to and music can be used to enhance the stillness of reflection.
