The Christmas Story

As we cannot perform a Nativity or lead you through a Carol Service, we have chosen to tell you the Christmas Story in a 'bubble friendly' way. Each family will have received a consent form about the filming of the story, please complete and return as soon as possible. Each class bubble will tell part of the story and sing a song to match before the next class tell the next part of the story. Mrs Henson has kindly agreed to film each section (following all Covid secure routines as you would expect) and then make it look fabulous as always! If you have any questions about this, please do not hesitate to ask.

Each class is also learning a Christmas dance which will be filmed in the same manner and shared via the school's private YouTube account. As usual, I remind all families that the link to the account is for **your own household to use only** and is **NOT** to be shared widely with other people or wider family members - they can watch it with you as and when families can get together. I will be most disappointed if I find that families do not respect this request as I feel it will be a breach of the excellent trust that we have between home and school.

Christmas lunch will be served on Tuesday 15th December this year. It will be a warm turkey roll, with mini roast potatoes, chipolata sausage, stuffing and a Christmas biscuit. A form has been sent home via ParentMail for you to order in advance for your child. We already have 60 requests so thank you to those who have already responded. Please ensure the form is completed by this Friday as Helen needs to order the turkey in advance.

Testing for Covid-19 - please read carefully and thoroughly

It is important that if your child becomes unwell with any of the COVID-19 symptoms listed below that you get tested. Testing sites are available across Cheshire and Merseyside, with appointments for tests released daily throughout the day and a new centre has opened locally in Ellesmere Port.

At this time of such high demand it is crucial that **only** people who have **COVID-19 symptoms** book a test. These include:

- a high temperature – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a new, continuous cough – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

There is no need for members of a pupil's household to have a test, unless they are also symptomatic but **ALL** members of the household do need to isolate until the test results are back.

If your child tests positive they should self-isolate and stay off school for 10 days, the rest of the household need to isolate for at least 14 days. If the test comes back negative they can return to school if they no longer have symptoms and have been fever free for 48hrs.
